<p>Student Shout!</p> <p>Purpose:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• To be responsible to the Board of Studies for the discussion and provision of advice on matters concerning the broader student experience, strategic direction of the University Centre Yeovil, and development of curriculum.• Where required the Student Shout! will furthermore be involved in upholding or evolving Quality Assurance, Regulatory, and Academic Standards in line with student-driven ambition to benefit the institution.
<p>Membership</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Chair/Lead – To be nominated and voted in by the student body from the learner population• Vice-Chair - Director of Higher Education• Members of academic staff by reason of their role as determined by the Board of Studies. This will normally include academic staff with strategic and/or management responsibilities to support responsiveness to issues raised by students.• Students by category of representation to be determined by the Board of Studies. Student representatives will normally outweigh staff representation.• Students' Union Officer• HE Learning Support Advisor or nominee• HE Programmes Administrator or nominee• Other support services (Learning Resources, Facilities, IT, Finance) to be co-opted where required. <p>Quorum -50% of eligible members</p>
<p>Objectives:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• To oversee the broad student experience and to identify areas for development (either curriculum or non-curriculum based)• To act as a forum for discussion of both academic and non-academic student-related matters, including• services and resources provided to support the student experience.• To advise the Board of Studies on the strategic direction of student support and curriculum.• To contribute to the development of the student community.• To make recommendations to enhance the student experience and to ensure that students are aware of actions being taken.• To further develop the institution's relationship with the Student body in relation to the social and learning• experience of students and matters of student representation through a collegiate community.
